Write a report based on an interview with one of your peers.

Have a clear purpose when you set out to interview your subject, whether it is their long-term goals, whether they have any outstanding achievements or experiences, or any other focus that is relevant to your subject.

Before meeting with your interview partner, please read their Introduction and Resume draft. You will meet with your interview partner in Blackboard Groups to start the initial conversation. You can email each other, create a discussion board, or meet on BB Collaborate.

We will look at examples of good interviews in class and online, and we will talk about the best format for your report.

Your report should include an introduction explaining what you hoped to find out. Your conclusion should wrap up the focus of your investigation and refer to anything that changed or confirmed your initial expectations. Since you are writing about a person, make sure that your report displays respect and interest, regardless of whether you agree with everything the person says. Think of how you can tell a story using this interview with your peer, bringing yourself and your environment into the narration.

Since this assignment will be included in your Final Portfolio, please ask your interview partner whether they are willing to share a photograph either of themselves or of something that represents them.
