This is a creative writing assignment. You can choose one of the following genres:

- Short fiction
- Creative nonfiction
- Poetry chapbook
- A genre of your choice

Please write at least 700 words, if you choose an essay as the main portion of this assignment.

You have the option to create a work other than an essay. Possible examples are:

- A short video
- A cartoon
- A performance piece
- A piece of music

If you decide to create a non-essay work, either it must contain at least 200 words, or you need to write a 200 word synopsis of your work.

The theme of this piece is IDENTITY. You can write about yourself, or you can write about a person you are interested in, or you can write about an imaginary person or creature.

Think about one specific incident or interest you can focus on related to your subject. A short time period and narrow focus will give you the opportunity to focus on the details, and how to bring a subject to life.
